Since then, he is called Mahatma Jyothirao Pule. Dr. Syed Mir Hassim, Director, IQAC, observed that he fought against child marriages, brought in several social reforms and upheld his altruistic nature. Head, Department of Telugu, G. Srinivas, said that Jyothirao Pule envisioned a society free from caste and religious discriminations. Dr. B. Sarasvathi, Lecturer in Telugu, said that he is known for providing education to the hyphenated individuals, women and many needy. She also said that the couple, Mahatma Jyothirao Pule and Savitribai Pule constructed a home for widows and the first school for girls in the country. SRINIVASA RAMANUJAN DEATH ANNIVERSARY: ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT MATH GENIUS

Srinivasa Iyengar Ramanujan continues to be an inspiration for mathematicians across the world. The self-taught genius lived a short but very productive life and his works have inspired a lot of researchers over the years. His birth anniversary on December 22nd is celebrated as the National Mathematics Day.

Ramanujan was born at Erode town in Tamil Nadu on December 22nd, 1887, and grew up in a small house at Kumbakonam which is now turned into a museum. His father worked as a clerk and his mother was a homemaker. He showed advanced mathematical cognition as a child and at the age of 13, he had started working on his own sophisticated theorems. Reports say that Ramanujan used to jot down his ideas in green ink. One of his notebooks, known as the **'Lost Notebook'**, was found in the Trinity College library and was later published into a book.

In January 1913, he sent the writer of Orders of Infinity and Other Works to G H Hardy. Hardy reviewed Ramanujan's work and labeled them as "fraud" but a month later, he invited the young Indian to Cambridge University. After initially refusing to go, Ramanujan joined Cambridge and was soon hailed there as a hero of mathematics.

The program was conducted by Department of Mathematics. The Chief Guest of this Event was Sri. N. J. K. Narendra Kumar, Vice-Principal. Dr. D. Devanandam and staff members attended the program.



WORLD MALARIA DAY - 2022

Department of Zoology observed **World Malaria Day** on 25th April. **Theme of WMD 2022 "Harness innovation to reduce the Malaria disease burden and save lives"** Malaria disease caused by Plasmodium vivax (parasite) is spread to humans through bite of an infected Female Anopheles Mosquito. It can be life threatening if not treated on time although it is very much presentable and curable. A person infected by Malaria parasite would start symptoms in 10-15 days of infection. Though it's infection possible that the parasite remain dormant for up to one year.

Symptoms: Fever, chills, headache, nausea, vomiting, fatigue, abdominal pain, rapid breathing and cough.



WORLD EARTH DAY - 2022

Department of Botany conducted **“World Earth day”** on **22-04-2022** along with Department of Zoology and Physics. 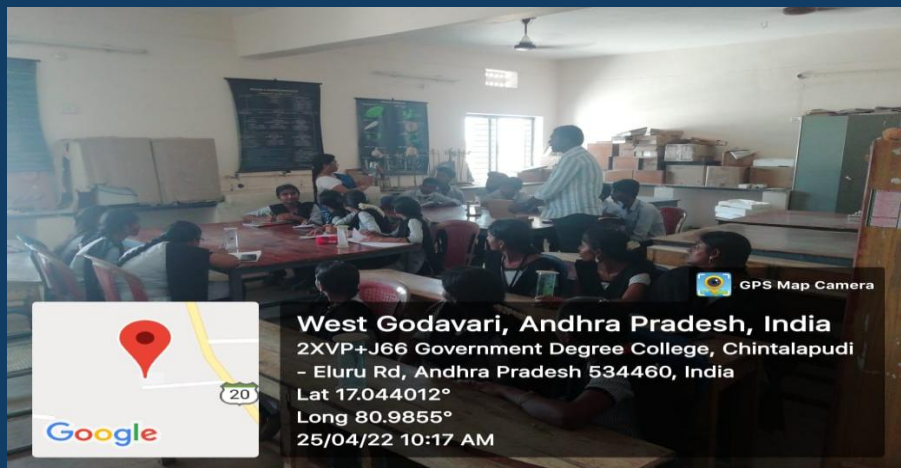
